GETTING THERE – OUR NEW HOME AT THE ICC DARLING HARBOUR HAS BRAND NEW TRANSPORT OPTIONS

We recommend public transport and there are several options available:

By Ferry: Cruise into Darling Harbour. Direct services operate from Circular Quay to King Street Wharf or Pyrmont Bay Wharf (in front of the Australian National Maritime Museum). Both are only a short walk away from ICC Sydney.

By Light Rail: Alight at either of two stops: Exhibition Centre (closest) or Convention. The light rail system connects with Central Station and Sydney's inner west. To plan your trip, visit www.sydneylightrail.transport.nsw.gov.au

Take the Train, alight at either Town Hall

or Central: Town Hall: Take the train to Town Hall Station and exit south into Bathurst Street. A short downhill walk along Bathurst Street will take you directly to Tumbalong Park and ICC Sydney.

Central: Take the train to Central Station and follow the signs to the South Concourse and UTS via the Devonshire Street Tunnel. Go west to cross beneath George Street. Then take the Ultimo Pedestrian Network and The Goods Line to its northern end, at Macarthur Street. Turn right and cross Darling Drive onto Hay Street. Turn left into Darling Harbour where Quay Street meets Hay Street.

By Bus: Buses operate across the Sydney metropolitan area seven days a week. The most convenient stop to ICC Sydney is Harris Street near Allen Street, Pyrmont, a 10-minute walk from the venue. For more information about routes and timetables, visit www.sydneybuses.info

Car or Taxi Drop off: Go to ICC Sydney, 14 Darling Drive, Sydney. Taxi ranks are located at Iron Wharf Place alongside the Convention Centre, and the second is in Zollner Circuit at the southern end of the ICC Theatre.

THE SYDNEY QUILT SHOW running in conjunction with the Sydney Craft & Quilt Fair is back at Darling Harbour with a spectacular show this year.

PRESENTATION CEREMONY is on Thursday at 1pm, in the Sydney Quilt Show area.



The show will feature more than 400 members' quilts, Best of Australia quilts from each state; floortalks by Rhonda Pearce and Carolyn Sullivan; Repurposed, Recycled, Reloved challenge with furniture items recycled with patchwork and textiles. There'll also be an activity centre with hands-on quiltmaking for everyone of all ages and genders, and a new display of hoops showcasing a diverse array of quilt styles.

Craft & Quilt Fair highlights include: the AQC 2017 Challenge quilts themed Made in Australia: Flora & Fauna. Winner of the challenge is Linden Lancaster's spectacular Kangaroo & Wattle quilt (pictured).

Guest artist from the UK:

Knit and crochet lovers will be able to meet world-renowned designer-author Kerry Lord (pictured). Kerry's books Edward's Menagerie and Edward's Imaginarium have been a huge success

with wonderful characters to make with just a ball of yarn. 'Get ready to spend time with a suave high-flying rhino, a lovesick elephant who knows her way around a kitchen, and a seriously chivalrous tiger...'

Local **textile artists** are focusing on making Magical Creatures in felt and textiles. Their 'Meet the Artist' activity will include felt maker extraordinaire Rae Woolnough and textile artist Margaret Millar who loves felting and mixed media, hand dyeing, printing and silkscreening.

Patches at Work will be the theme of **Cavalcade of Fashion's display.** Vintage patchwork clothing, accessories and homewares will feature including an 1880s crazy quilt and a quilt made of 1950s dress fabrics.

Workshops, retailers and many more activities will all be part of the fair.
